# BAHRAIN YACHT CLUB & MARINA

## Application For Membership

This fully completed form should be submitted to the Club Reception, along with:

1. One photograph of applicant (partner if applicable).
2. Copy of both sides of CPR Card (partner if applicable).
3. Full payment of Subs and Fees due.

Applicants will then be granted probationary membership, pending approval at the next Executive Committee Meeting.

Membership subscriptions are payable in advance on the 31<sup>st</sup> March of each year. The fees are as follows:

### Family membership

(Full year) ..... BD 300  
(Six-month increments) ..... BD 350 (BD 175 per six month period).

### Individual membership

(Full year) ..... BD 200  
(Six-month increments) ..... BD 125 (BD125 per six month period).

If a boat mooring or hardstanding berth is required details of the craft must be on file at the BYC. This includes:

1. Personal Sailing Permit
2. Boat Registration
3. Boat Insurance

Mooring fees must be paid and a copy of the insurance certificate given to the BYC administrator. All these procedures must be completed BEFORE bringing any watercraft onto club premises. Only a fully paid up members are permitted to keep vessels on Bahrain Yacht Club premises and all such watercraft must have valid insurance cover at all times.

Membership fees must be fully paid up whilst a watercraft is moored/parked on BYC premises. Payment of lapsed membership fees, in addition to any outstanding mooring or hard standing fees must be made in full before a watercraft can be removed from BYC premises. Watercraft, trailers, or any other associated equipment left on the BYC premises by non paid up members, for a continuous period of 12 months or more, will be deemed to have been abandoned, and will be sold to recover outstanding fees and dues.
